Should you charge a battery before first use?

First charge: myths vs. reality You might have heard this advice, especially from older mobile phone manuals: "Charge your battery for 8 hours before first use." This was true for NiCd batteries, which suffered from memory effect and benefitted from full charges. However, this is not true for modern lithium batteries.

How long does it take to charge a cell phone?

The best practice is simple: Use the charger that came with your device or one rated correctly for your battery. Plug it in and let it charge to full--usually around 4.2V per cell. Once the charger indicates a full charge, it's ready to use. This process typically takes 1 to 3 hours, depending on the battery size and charge rate.

How long does a car battery take to charge?

Charging time depends on the battery's capacity and the charger's amperage. A standard car battery may take 4-24 hours to fully charge.
